

Pueblo Crime Stoppers is asking for your assistance in locating the person responsible for the following crime: Identity Theft

We don't want your name, just the information

On July 15, 2013 at 10:10 p.m. two suspects stole a wallet from Wal-Mart (4080 W. Northern Ave.) and used its contents to commit Identity Theft minutes later.

The owner of the wallet left the wallet behind at a register #5 after paying for merchandise. The suspects approached the register and the female points out the wallet to her male companion. The woman takes the wallet from the counter and hands it to the man. The man attempts to conceal it in the grocery cart next to a small child but then moves it to a bag inside of the cart.

Moments later, the male is seen exiting the passenger side of a solid red or maroon in color larger mini-van, perhaps a Ford Windstar or Kia Sedona, at the Loaf and Jug convenience store adjacent Wal-Mart. The license plate cannot be read, however, the male is seen fueling the van using contents from the victim's wallet.

The male suspect is described as a Hispanic, wearing a black shirt, black shorts, and dark shoes – possible tattoos along both arms. The female is Caucasian or Hispanic, wearing a gray shirt, black shorts, black flip-flops, and hair pulled up. The way she is walking, she appears maybe to be pregnant. They appear to be in their mid 20's to early 30's. The child in the grocery cart appears to be 2-3 years old, wearing a black shirt.
