 Notice of Public Hearings

The City of Pueblo and Pueblo County, under the HOME Investment Partnership Act Program, are seeking public comment on the development of the 2010-2014 Pueblo Consortium Consolidated Plan. The Consolidated Plan is a U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requirement that outlines the Consortium’s housing and non-housing community development needs. Specifically the Plan describes the Consortium’s strategy to allocate federal HOME Program (\$900,000), and the City’s strategy to allocate federal CDBG Program (\$1.6million) funds. City Council is expected to adopt the Plan in December 2009. The City is the Entitlement Jurisdiction under HUD and administers the funding.

The Consolidated Plan creates a unified 5-year strategy. It provides data, a strategy, and an action plan with the necessary linkages and partnerships that the City intends to use for implementing the goals of the Plan. The public hearings will focus on:

1. Addressing local housing needs for low and moderate income persons;
2. Quality of life;
3. Neighborhood social and physical infrastructure needs;
4. And economic development needs for low and moderate-income persons.
