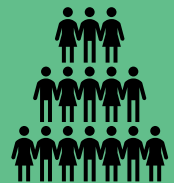
PUEBLO COUNTY

- No victim

Referral

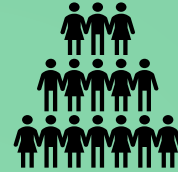
- Referred by a community member or law enforcement officer

Supplies such as groceries, clothing, hygiene products.

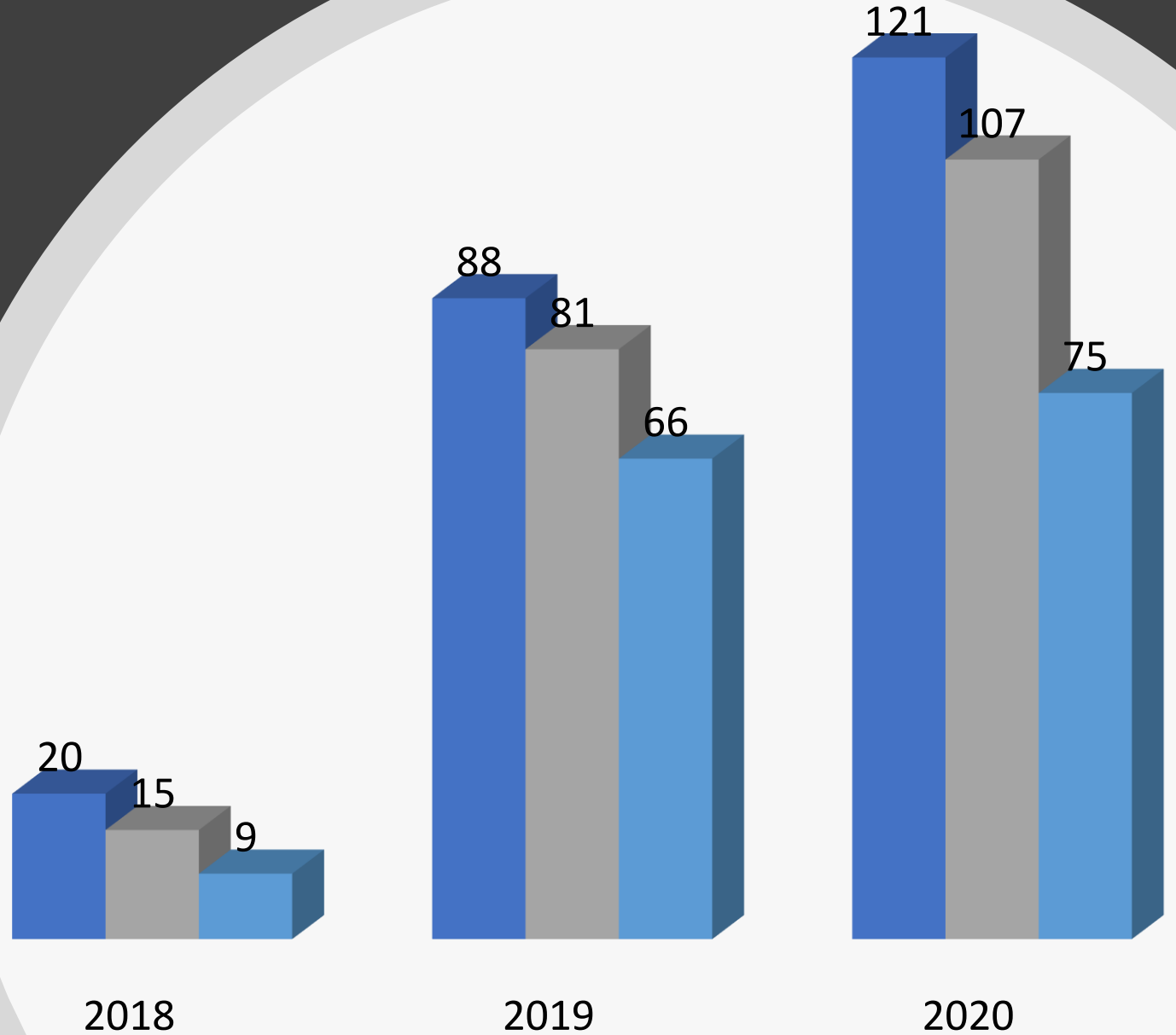
