BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF PUEBLO, that:

SECTION 1.

The attached Revocable Permit is authorized to be issued to The Rocky Mountain Collegiate Cycling Conference for the use of the downtown streets to include parts of Union Avenue, Victoria Avenue, Alan Hamel Avenue, C Street, D Street, Main Street, City Center Drive, and Greenwood Street and their right of ways from April 23, 2022 at 6:00 am, until 7:00 pm to host their Pueblo Classic Bicycle Race.

SECTION 2.

The use of the public right of ways granted hereby is subject to all limitations, terms, and conditions set forth in the attached Revocable Permit.

SECTION 3.

The officers and staff of the City are authorized to perform any and all acts consistent with this Resolution to implement the policies and procedures described herein.


SECTION 4.
