I am first generation immigrant and am now considered a senior citizen.

As a spouse in an interracial marriage, I have been in a quagmire in which my race and my husband's, has led to us being discriminated against both financially and emotionally. My father immigrated from Yugoslavia (now Slovenia) when he was a young man, his English at times held a heavy Slavic accent. We many were laughed at, and I felt it affected his career. Growing up our foods and traditions were different than most American families so as a young adult I found myself struggling to adapt to the American lifestyle and in some instances the proper English language structure.
