SUBJECT: AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPROVING A LICENSE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF PUEBLO, A COLORADO MUNICIPAL CORPORATION AND THE STATE OF COLORADO, COLORADO STATE FAIR AUTHORITY AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAME

SUMMARY:

This Emergency Ordinance approves a license agreement for use of facilities at the Colorado State Fairgrounds in support of a community clean up event (“Team Up to Clean Up”) scheduled to be held on May 21, 2022.

PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION:

None.

BACKGROUND:

The Pueblo Department of Public Health and Environment (PDPHE) and the City of Pueblo are jointly planning a City-wide clean up event to be held on May 21, 2022, for the benefit of City residents. This event will be held at two locations in the City – one at the CSU-Pueblo campus on the north side and one at the Colorado State Fairgrounds on the south side.

The Colorado State Fair has requested the City to enter into a license agreement for use of the facility to host the event. All fees associated with the use of the facility have been waived under the terms of the license agreement.

ORDINANCE NO. 10176

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPROVING A LICENSE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF PUEBLO, A COLORADO MUNICIPAL CORPORATION AND THE STATE OF COLORADO, COLORADO STATE FAIR AUTHORITY AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAME

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF PUEBLO, that:

SECTION 1.

The License Agreement for Use of Facility between the City of Pueblo, A Colorado Municipal Corporation, and the State of Colorado, Colorado State Fair Authority, a copy of which is attached hereto ("Agreement"), having been approved as to form by the City Attorney, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2.

The City Council finds this Ordinance qualifies for treatment as an emergency ordinance pursuant to City Charter because of the urgent need to timely facilitate a City-wide clean up event to mitigate impacts associated with illegal dumping, to protect local environmental resources, and to maintain the health and safety of City residents.

SECTION 3.

The Mayor is authorized to execute and deliver the Agreement in the name of the City and the City Clerk is directed to affix the seal of the City thereto and attest same.

SECTION 4.

The officers and staff of the City are authorized to perform any and all acts consistent with the intent of the Ordinance and Agreement to implement the policies and procedures described therein.

SECTION 5.

This Ordinance shall become effective on the date of final action by the Mayor and City Council.
