SUMMARY:

The revocable permit submitted by La Gente Youth Sports, Inc., to host their annual Juan Madrid Memorial Tournament is amended to be conducted June17, 2022 thru June 19, 2022.

The officers and staff of the City are authorized to perform any and all acts consistent with the intent of this Resolution to implement the policies and procedures described herein.


SECTION 4.
