SUBJECT: A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT BY THE MAYOR OF
PATRICK AVALOS TO THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION

SUMMARY:

This Resolution confirms the appointment by the Mayor of a member to the Planning and Zoning Commission to serve a four-year term expiring July 1, 2026.

PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION:

City Council has made appointments to the Planning and Zoning Commission selecting individuals to serve terms which expire during a calendar year. Amended City Charter Section 4-4 (i) now requires that such appointments be made by the Mayor, subject to confirmation by City Council.

BACKGROUND:

Due to the term expiration of Patrick Avalos, there is one spot available to serve a four-year term expiring July 1, 2026 on the Planning & Zoning Commission.

Following an announcement on the City's webpage, social media, and in the Pueblo Chieftain seeking volunteers to serve on this committee, an application was received from Mr. Avalos who is interested in and eligible for reappointment.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

Planning and Zoning Commission Members receive as compensation \$25.00 for each regular or special meeting attended. The Chairman of the Board receives as additional compensation the sum of \$50.00 per month for each month of service as Chairman. These monies are allocated in the Planning and Community Development's annual budget.
