BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF PUEBLO, that:

SECTION 1.

SECTION 2.

The City Clerk is directed to cause said Revocable Permit to be forthwith recorded in the office of the Pueblo County Clerk and Recorder.


SECTION 5.
