**Disparate Certification**

A disparate allocation occurs when a city or municipality is scheduled to receive one and one-half times (150 percent) more than a county with concurrent jurisdiction, while that county bears more than 50 percent of the costs associated with prosecution or incarceration of the municipality's Part 1 violent crime. Multiple disparate allocations occur when multiple cities or municipalities are collectively eligible to receive four times (400 percent) more than the county.

JAG disparate jurisdictions are certified by the Director of the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA), based in part on input from the state's Attorney General. 5	Bluetooth wireless headsets for Crisis Negotiation Team	PPD CNT	\$1,600	This project proposes to purchase 8 Bluetooth wireless headsets for use by the Crisis Negotiation Team allowing for hands free communication with suspects.
6	Grappling mats for academy	PPD Academy	\$3,168	This project proposes to purchase 77 grappling mats for use in the Training section for the academy and for in-service training. These mats will ensure safer training for all involved. These will also allow for multiple classes.
7	Loudspeaker	PPD Patrol	\$3,738	This project proposes to purchase 25 handheld controllers which will enable officers to utilize the loudspeaker from the rear of the car providing for increased safety to the officers.
