SUBJECT: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A REVOCABLE PERMIT TO THE PUEBLO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT, FOR THE USE OF THE PARKING LOT AND DRIVEWAY AT EL PUEBLO MUSEUM

SUMMARY:

The Pueblo Department of Public Health and Environment (PDPHE) is hosting an event at the El Pueblo Museum on April 30, 2022 and has requested the parking lot be closed for the event.

PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION:

BACKGROUND:

PDPHE is hosting a "SOCOYOGO" event on April 30, 2022 that will take place at El Pueblo Museum. A portion of the event will be held in the parking lot and driveway on the south and east sides of the museum facility. While revocable permits are not normally issued for use of parking lots, this particular area is a public right-of-way. Under the terms of the proposed permit, the parking lot would be closed to vehicular traffic from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM on the day of the event.

SECTION 1.

SECTION 2.

The use of the public right-of-way granted hereby is subject to all limitations, terms, and conditions set forth in the attached Revocable Permit.

The officers and staff of the City are authorized to perform any and all acts consistent with this Resolution to implement the policies and procedures described herein.

SECTION 4.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval.
