SUBJECT: A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S REAPPOINTMENT OF THE
PRESIDING JUDGE OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT

SUMMARY:

The attached Resolution confirms the reappointment of Carla Sikes as Presiding Judge of the Municipal Court.

PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION:

On April 23, 2018, by Resolution No. 13955, City Council appointed Carla Sikes as Presiding Municipal Judge of the Municipal Court for the City of Pueblo for a two-year term beginning May 1, 2018 and expiring on April 30, 2020. On April 13, 2020, by Resolution No. 14392, City Council reappointed Carla Sikes as Presiding Municipal Judge for a two-year term beginning May 1, 2020 and expiring on April 30, 2022.

BACKGROUND:

This Resolution confirms the Mayor's reappointment of Carla Sikes as Presiding Municipal Judge of the Municipal Court for the City of Pueblo for a term of two years beginning May 1, 2022 and expiring on April 30, 2024.

The Presiding Judge of the Municipal Court receives a salary and related benefits as set forth in an annual budget approved by City Council.
