For fifteen years I was an Air Traffic Controller at both Lowry Air Force Base and later as a civilian at Buckley Air National Guard Base (now Buckley Air Force Base). During one year when many of the employees (guardsmen) were called to active duty, I acted as Assistant Air Operations Supervisor scheduling air traffic controllers, dispatchers, and overseeing the office of aircraft safety.

Later, as Director of Communications and Public Relations for the Denver Board of Realtors I worked closely with then Mayor of Denver, Federico Pena, to successfully influence the building of a new airport. That airport opened in the late '90s as Denver International Airport and has greatly influenced the enormous economic growth the Denver now enjoys.

Pueblo has an excellent airport with an excellent manager, but it appears to enjoy only minimum use. It has an excellent refueling and maintenance stop with Flowers Aviation, a charming and clean restaurant with a great menu, and the highly rated Weisbrod Aircraft Museum to name only a few of the assets. With the encouragement and support of the city, Pueblo Memorial Airport has the capacity to be an economic boon. Its importance in this area should not be minimized.

Anything encouraging economic growth for Pueblo would be a plus.
