# WHO WE ARE

- 135-137 full-time employees
- Average age – 44.3 years old
- Average years of service – 12.79 (two employees with 36 years, four with 35 days)
- Employees with licenses and/or certifications – 77 percent
- Three locations – Administration, Engineering and Whitlock Treatment Plant
- Governed by an independent five-person elected board of directors, with each board member serving six-year staggered terms

- Offer low costs compared to other communities along the Front Range
- 41,283 active accounts
- 73 square miles of service area
