SUBJECT: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A REVOCABLE PERMIT TO THE COLORADO STATE FAIR, FOR USE OF THE SMALL AVENUE RIGHT-OF-WAY, BETWEEN EUCLID AVENUE AND SCRANTON AVENUE, TO ALLOW FOR PARKING SCHOOL BAND BUSES AND EQUIPMENT VEHICLES

SUMMARY:

Attached is an application for a revocable permit submitted by the Colorado State Fair to use Small Avenue.

BACKGROUND:

The Colorado State Fair is requesting the closure of Small Avenue, between Beulah Avenue and Scranton Avenue, on August 27, 2022, from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm. This will allow for parking school band buses and equipment vehicles and provide a safe environment for loading and unloading of students, teachers, and equipment.

SECTION 1.

SECTION 2.

The use of the public right-of-way granted hereby is subject to all limitations, terms, and conditions set forth in the attached Revocable Permit.

SECTION 3.

The officers and staff of the City are authorized to perform any and all acts consistent with the intent of this Resolution to implement the policies and procedures described herein.


SECTION 4.
