SUMMARY:

The event takes place at the Historic Courthouse in Pueblo and kicks off the holiday season every year with a big fireworks show and this year includes the addition of a laser show.

PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION:

Council contributed \$500 for this event in 2021.

BACKGROUND:

The 2022 festivities will kick off at 5 p.m. with music, food trucks, hot chocolate, and first responder vehicles on display. The lighting ceremony will take place at 7 p.m. with a fireworks show completely coordinated to music. This year will also have a phenomenal laser light show to complement our fireworks display. Financial support will help the County pay for the expenses related to the event.
