Resolution No. 2022-1

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS OF PUEBLO, COLORADO that:

The Ordinance directing that the November 8, 2022 General Municipal Election be Conducted as Part of a Coordinated Election, Adopting for Use at the General Municipal Election the Requirements and Procedures of the Uniform Election Code of 1992 except to the extent the Uniform Code of 1992 Conflicts with a specific provision of the Charter of the City of Pueblo, and suspending for such purposes all Ordinances and Resolutions of the City in conflict therewith, was reviewed by the Board of Election.

Upon a motion made by Alvin Rivera and seconded by Marisa Stoller and unanimously adopted, the Board of Elections recommends the Adoption of the Ordinance by the City Council to constitute the election procedures, rules, and regulations, as to the matters set forth in Section 17-7 of the Charter and the Uniform Election Code of 1992.
