SUMMARY:

The attached Ordinance approves and authorizes the Mayor to sign a paid internship agreement with Colorado State University-Pueblo ("CSU-P").

BACKGROUND:

The Multimedia Communication Intern position with the City of Pueblo in the Mayor's Office, under the supervision of the Director of Public Affairs, will be tasked wide range of assignments based upon the individual's educational experience. Duties and responsibilities may include, but are not limited to the following: Attend weekly meetings and other departmental-related meetings that facilitate learning. Research the current state of public access channels 17 and 19. Assist with social media management and content creation. Assist with the Implementation of social media assets for the City of Pueblo. Make recommendations for updating current communication (visual to include graphic design or video work) including public access channels, social media, flyers/announcements, and other modes of communication related to City of Pueblo. Help departmental staff with creative or design needs. Meet with other City of Pueblo departments such as Pueblo Fire, Pueblo Parks and Recreation, and Pueblo Police Department to assist with cohesive and consistent branding and communication methods or projects. Attend meetings with community partners to assist with communication and promotional needs related to input and responsibility of City of Pueblo.

The salary for the CSU-P intern is included in the 2022 fiscal year budget.

ORDINANCE NO. 10231

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A PAID INTERNSHIP SITE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM, ACTING BY AND THROUGH COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY PUEBLO AND THE CITY OF PUEBLO, A COLORADO MUNICIPAL CORPORATION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF PUEBLO, that:

SECTION 1.

The Paid Internship Site Agreement (“Agreement”) between the City of Pueblo, a Colorado municipal corporation and the Board of Governors of the Colorado State University System acting by and through Colorado State University Pueblo, dated May 26, 2022, a copy of which is attached hereto, having been approved as to form by the City Attorney, is hereby approved. The Mayor is authorized to execute and deliver said Agreement in the name of the City and the City Clerk is authorized to affix the seal of the City thereto and attest same.

SECTION 2.

The officers and staff of the City are authorized to perform any and all acts consistent with this Ordinance and the attached Agreement to implement the policies and procedures described therein.

SECTION 3.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final action by the Mayor and City Council *nunc pro tunc* May 26, 2022.
