SUBJECT: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A REVOCABLE PERMIT TO VESSEL BREWING COMPANY, LLC, DBA GOLD DUST SALOON FOR THE USE OF RIGHT OF WAY AT 217 SOUTH UNION AVENUE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ANNUAL CHILE AND FRIJOLES FESTIVAL

SUMMARY:

This Resolution approves the issuance of a Revocable Permit to the Vessel Brewing Company, LLC, to participate in the annual Chile and Frijoles Festival.

PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION:

Revocable permit and Resolution approved.

BACKGROUND:

Vessel Brewing Company, LLC, has requested the use of the right-of-way at 217 South Union Avenue from September 23, 2022, at 10:00 a.m. until September 25, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. to participate in the annual Chile and Frijoles Festival. Although the Pueblo Chamber of Commerce has applied for a Revocable Permit for this event, the State Liquor Law is requiring Vessel Brewing Company, LLC, to modify its licensed premises in order to sell alcohol outside the premises of their establishment.
