A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ADOPTING PUEBLO COUNTY'S EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN (AUGUST 2022)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF PUEBLO, that:

SECTION 1.

The Emergency Operations Plan ("EOP") for Pueblo County, Colorado (August 2022), a copy of which is attached hereto and is incorporated herein by this reference, having been approved as to form by the City of Pueblo's Police Chief, Fire Chief and Director of Public Works, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2.

The Mayor is authorized to execute and deliver said EOP in the name of the City and the City Clerk is authorized to fix the seal of the City thereto and attest same.

SECTION 3.

All agencies, departments and individuals employed by the City of Pueblo who are assigned responsibilities, specifically or by implication, in the attached EOP are hereby directed to recognize the Plan as an expression of the public policy of the City and that the responsibilities assigned therein shall constitute an integral part of their official duties and functions.

SECTION 4.

Minor revisions, as determined necessary by the Emergency Management Coordinator of Pueblo County, may be incorporated into the Plan as the need arises, without recourse to formal action by City Council, provided such changes are fully consistent with the basic purpose of the Plan as approved herein.

SECTION 5.

The attached Emergency Operations Plan supersedes and replaces previous EOP's approved and adopted by City Council.

SECTION 6.

The officers and staff of the City are authorized to perform any and all acts consistent with this Resolution and the attached EOP which are necessary or desirable to implement the policies and procedures described herein.

SECTION 7.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon final passage.
