Grants typically range from \$500 to \$1,500.

Additionally, the Foundation is committed to supporting all District staff and serves as a vehicle to award scholarships to deserving scholars.

As a fundraiser for the Foundation and to support its community-enriching work, the **Cornhole at the Dutch**, a cornhole tournament will be staged at Dutch Clark Stadium on Saturday, October 1.

In both competitive and advanced divisions, first-, second- and third-place finishers will be rewarded with prizes. Your financial support and sponsorship will ensure that this event will be fun and engaging for participants as well as enriching for the Foundation.

Throughout the year, the Foundation is a host to a number of high-profile annual events, including the salute to veterans and active duty military known as Pride and Patriotism and the Peace Summit, which is designed to increase solidarity and inclusiveness.
