

PUEBLO LIQUOR & BEER LICENSING BOARD
MINUTES -- REGULAR MEETING

The Pueblo Liquor & Beer Licensing Board convened the Regular Meeting of August 20, 2014 at 6:00 p.m., with Chairwoman Doris Harrison presiding.

8 SPECIAL EVENTS PERMIT APPLICATION-BEER, WINE & SPIRITUOUS LIQUOR LICENSE– THE STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY OF COLORADO D/B/A EL PUEBLO HISTORY MUSEUM, MAILING ADDRESS: 301 N. UNION AVENUE, EVENT MANAGER: SIMON TEARPAK, (EVENT TO BE HELD SEPTEMBER 20, 2014. ADDRESS OF EVENT: 301 N. UNION AVENUE)

Event manager Simon Tearpak, 311 Arthur Street, was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. Mr. Tearpak stated this event is called “Bruja Brew Fest” and the funds from the ticket sales will go directly towards funding their educational programs. Mr. Tearpak will be responsible for supervising the event. There are 17 liquor distribution points and there will be 17 different beer-tasting vendor booths. Mr. Tearpak stated Adobe Mesa will cater the event. Mr. Tearpak described approved forms of I.D. and stated the patrons will be checked upon entering the event, regardless of age, and no one under the age of 21 will allowed in to the event. TNT Security will be assigned to maintain order on the licensed premises and alcohol will not be allowed off the licensed premises. Mr. Tearpak stated the licensed premises will be secured with fencing from Taylor fencing which will surround the outdoor plaza and additional fencing will be placed around the park area.

The Board held a brief discussion expressing concerns with the amount of alcohol that will be available from the 17 different vendors. Mr. Tearpak explained a patron may sample 2 oz. pours. The Board recommended that Mr. Tearpak remind the vendors they need to avoid serving visibly intoxicated patrons. Mr. Pullaro stated he would like to see a punch-card system implemented as a way to help prevent someone from being over-served. Mr. Tearpak stated that was a good suggestion and stated security will also be watching.

Mr. DiFatta, seconded by Mr. Rose, moved to approve this Special Events Permit. Roll Call: Ayes—DiFatta, Ferris, Harrison, Pullaro and Rose. Motion carried unanimously.

ADDRESS OF EVENT: PARKING LOT BETWEEN GRAND AVENUE & VICTORIA TO UNION AVENUE (EL PUEBLO HISTORY MUSEUM PARKING LOT) AND SISTER CITY PLAZA)

Event manager Rod Slyhoff, 1242 Palmer Avenue, was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. Mr. Slyhoff stated this event is for the “Sister City International Festival” and the proceeds raised will help support the Chamber. Mr. Slyhoff will be responsible for supervising the event. There will be 1 liquor distribution point and 6 persons per 4-hour shift will be selling/serving alcohol. Mr. Slyhoff described the types of food that will be served; he also described approved forms of I.D. and

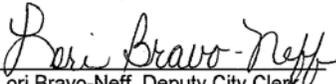
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stated all patrons will be required to show an I.D. and if they are 21 years of age, they will be given a wristband which must be worn in order to be able to purchase alcohol. TNT Security will be assigned to maintain order on the licensed premises and alcohol will not be allowed off the licensed premises. Mr. Slyhoff stated the licensed premises will be secured with interlocking metal fencing.

Mr. Ferris, seconded by Mr. DiFatta, moved to approve this Special Events Permit. Roll Call: Ayes— DiFatta, Ferris, Harrison, Pullaro and Rose. Motion carried unanimously.

ADJOURN – With no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 6:31 p.m.
