Neighborhood Surveyor Don Vest, 516 Lincoln was sworn in and presented to the Board the demographics and map of the defined neighborhood for issuance of a new Brew Pub Liquor License/new Cabaret License for premises to be known as *Brues Alehouse Brewing Company*.

Mr. Pullaro, seconded by Mr. Ferris, moved to receive the survey and set the hearing for September 17th, 2014. Roll Call: Ayes—DiFatta, Ferris, Harrison, Pullaro and Rose. Motion carried unanimously.

Event manager Dennis Lowry, 311 W. Evans, was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. Mr. Lowry stated this event is their 6th Annual Comedy Night and the funds raised from the ticket sales will go towards funding their programs. Mr. Lowry will be responsible for supervising the event. There is 1 liquor distribution point and there will be 2 persons selling/serving alcohol. Mr. Lowry stated there will be a full buffet dinner. Mr. Lowry described approved forms of I.D. and stated the patrons identification will be checked upon entering the event, and a wristband will be placed on the wrist of anyone who is 21 years of age. Mr. Lowry explained *The Albany* provides security to maintain order on the licensed premises and alcohol will not be allowed off the licensed premises. Mr. Lowry explained there is only one main point of entry and there are alarms on all other doors around the perimeter of this establishment. When asked about the kitchen area not being included as part of the licensed premises, Mr. Lowry explained the kitchen area will be closed.

Mr. Rose, seconded by Mr. Ferris, moved to approve this Special Events Permit. Roll Call: Ayes—DiFatta, Ferris, Harrison, Pullaro and Rose. Motion carried unanimously.


