Event Manager Midori Clark, 612 E. 18th Street, Pueblo was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. Ms. Clark stated that there will be one alcohol distribution point and three servers during the event. There will be an unlimited buffet of hors d'oeuvres and desserts. The Library will be closed during the event and TNT will supply security. Anyone appearing under the age of 30 will be asked for identification. As all ages are welcome, wristbands will be utilized for bar patrons.

The Board requested that Ms. Clark provide a menu of buffet items to staff before the event.

Mr. Ferris, seconded by Mr. Rose, moved to approve the special events permit application for the Pueblo City-County Library District. Roll Call: Ayes – Ferris, Harrison, Pullaro, Rose, and Shafer. Motion carried 5-0.

9 PERMIT APPLICATION AND REPORT OF CHANGES – MODIFICATION OF PREMISES – TAVERN LIQUOR LICENSE – J & C D, INC. D/B/A CHUG-A-MUG, 1501 E. EVANS AVENUE

Registered Manager Charles Hall, 2323 Meadowlark Lane, Pueblo was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. Mr. Hall explained that he would like to modify the premises by creating an entrance from the existing building and installing a fence to enclose the patio thereby including the patio as part of the licensed premises. The bartender would have line of sight to the patio through the door to maintain the security of the premises.

Mr. Rose, seconded by Mr. Ferris, moved to approve the modification of premises for J & C D, Inc. d/b/a Chug-A-Mug. Roll Call: Ayes – Ferris, Harrison, Pullaro, Rose, and Shafer. Motion carried 5-0.

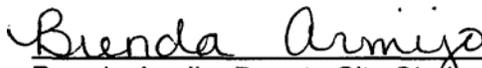
**11 PETITION TO PAY FINE IN LIEU OF SUSPENSION – IRON HORSE BAR & GRILL, INC.
