**7 SPECIAL EVENTS PERMIT APPLICATION – BEER, WINE & SPIRITUOUS LIQUOR LICENSE – POSADA, 225 COLORADO AVENUE, EVENT MANAGER: KIM BOWMAN (EVENT TO BE HELD MAY 7, 2016)**

Event Manager Kim Bowman, 315 Carlile Avenue, Pueblo and Katie Schilling, 15 Calhoun Road, Pueblo were sworn in and answered questions from the Board. Proceeds from the event will benefit Posada. Ms. Bowman stated that there will be one liquor distribution point with five staff servers and five support staff during the event. The menu includes Hot Derby Brown sandwiches, shrimp cocktail, fruits, and desserts. Ms. Bowman described approved forms of identification and gave examples. All attendees will have their identification checked and no one under the age of 21 will be allowed on the premises. Ms. Bowman explained that the premises is enclosed by a wrought iron fence with one entrance/exit. American security will have three staff members on site for the event.

Mr. Rose, seconded by Mr. Pullaro, moved to approve the special events permit application for Posada. Roll Call: Ayes – Ferris, Harrison, Pullaro, and Rose. Motion carried 4-0.


