7 SPECIAL EVENTS PERMIT APPLICATION – BEER, WINE & SPIRITUOUS LIQUOR LICENSE – JUNETEENTH ORGANIZATION OF PUEBLO, INC., MAILING ADDRESS: P.O. BOX 2335, EVENT ADDRESS: 1801 W. PUEBLO BOULEVARD, EVENT MANAGER: LAWRENCE DEPRIEST (EVENT TO BE HELD JUNE 18, 2016)

Event Manager Lawrence DePriest, 4903 Briarcrest Drive, Pueblo was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. Mr. DePriest stated that there will be one liquor distribution point with five servers during the event. The menu includes BBQ ribs, pulled pork, hamburgers, hot dogs, macaroni and cheese, and baked beans. Mr. DePriest described approved forms of identification and gave examples. This is an all age's event. Wrist bands will be utilized for bar patrons. Mr. DePriest explained that the premises will be secured by fencing. Titan Security will have three staff members on site for the event.

An amended, more detailed diagram was requested by Chairperson Harrison.

Mrs. Shafer, seconded by Mr. Rose, moved to approve the special events permit application for Juneteenth Organization of Pueblo, Inc. Roll Call: Ayes – Harrison, Pullaro, Rose and Shafer. Motion carried 4-0.

8 PERMIT APPLICATION & REPORT OF CHANGES – MANAGER'S REGISTRATION (HOTEL & RESTAURANT) — APPLE COLORADO LLC D/B/A APPLEBEE'S NEIGHBORHOOD GRILL & BAR

New Manager Michael Herman, 2714 Ontario Street, Pueblo, was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. The moral character questions were directed to Mr. Herman. He indicated that the restaurant currently employs approximately 65 people. Mr. Herman described approved forms of identification and explained that bartenders and servers check identification. Identification is checked for patrons appearing age 30 and under. Servers and bartenders participate in in-house Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSOA) training and must pass testing after completing four days of training. The moral character of Mr. Herman was found to be satisfactory to the Board.

Mr. Pullaro, seconded by Mrs. Shafer, moved to approve the manager's registration. Roll Call: Ayes — Harrison, Pullaro, Rose, and Shafer. Motion carried 4-0.


