New Manager Loretta Dunn, 205 S. Bailey Drive, Pueblo West, was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. The moral character questions were directed to Ms. Dunn. She indicated that the restaurant currently employs approximately 60 – 70 people depending on the time of year. Ms. Dunn described approved forms of identification and gave examples. Identification is checked for patrons appearing age 35 and under. Employees participate in in-house Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSOA) training, which is offered two times per year, usually in September and November. The moral character of Ms. Dunn was found to be satisfactory to the Board.

Mrs. Shafer, seconded by Mr. Ferris, moved to approve the manager's registration. Roll Call: Ayes — Ferris, Harrison, Pullaro, Rose, and Shafer. Motion carried 5-0.


Members Thomas Hogan, 141 Brentwood Drive, Pueblo and Melissa Ribal, 141 Brentwood Drive, Pueblo, were sworn in and answered questions from the Board. The moral character and financial questions were directed to both. Mr. Hogan and Ms. Ribal purchased Marlin and Associates from the previous owners, there are no silent partners. The liquor store currently employs nine people, with up to 12 employees during the busy season. Background checks are conducted on employees utilizing internet based companies. Mr. Hogan and Ms. Ribal described approved forms of identification and gave examples. All patrons are carded until employees know the first name of the patron. The moral character of Mr. Hogan and Ms. Ribal was found to be satisfactory to the Board.
