**6 PERMIT APPLICATION AND REPORT OF CHANGES – MODIFICATION OF PREMISES – TAVERN LIQUOR LICENSE – SANGRE DE CRISTO ARTS & CONFERENCE CENTER, INC. D/B/A SANGRE DE CRISTO ARTS & CONFERENCE CENTER, 210 N. SANTA FE AVENUE**

Lorrie Marquez, Manager of Conference Services, 3226 St. Clair, Pueblo was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. The temporary modification of premises is needed to allow a bar to be set up in the roundabout during Festival Friday events. The Arts & Conference Center has been hosting Festival Fridays for more than 20 years as a fundraiser for the Arts Center. Attendance is anticipated to be between 1000 and 1500 people per event. The site is secured by fencing and TNT Security provides on-site security during the events. Wrist bands are utilized for bar patrons.

Mr. Pullaro, seconded by Ms. Shafer, moved to approve the modification of premises contingent upon a completely executed routing sheet being submitted to the City Clerk's Office within five business days. Roll Call: Ayes – Harrison, Pullaro, and Shafer. Motion carried 3-0.

**7 HEARING: TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP APPLICATION – HOTEL & RESTAURANT LIQUOR LICENSE – J & C D, INC. D/B/A THE DRAFT SPORTS BAR & GRILL, 4065 CLUB MANOR DRIVE (CURRENTLY LICENSED TO WILD WINGS USA, LLC D/B/A THE DRAFT SPORTS BAR & GRILL, LICENSE EXPIRES NOVEMBER 6, 2016)**

Corporate Officers Wendy Hall, 2323 Meadowlark Lane, Pueblo, Charles Hall, 2323 Meadowlark Lane, Pueblo, and Registered Manager Charles Jay Hall, 10 Pineridge Court, Pueblo were sworn in and answered questions from the Board. The moral character questions were directed to all three applicants and the financial interest questions were directed to Mr. and Mrs. Hall. The Sports Bar currently employs seven people, plus security guards. Background checks are not currently performed, but references are called. Each listed approved forms of identification and gave examples. The policy for checking the ages of patrons was given as anyone appearing 35 or younger. The moral character of the applicants was found to be satisfactory to the Board.

Ms. Shafer, seconded by Ms. Harrison, moved to approve the Transfer of Ownership Application – Hotel & Restaurant Liquor License – J & C D, Inc. d/b/a The Draft Sports Bar & Grill, 4065 Club Manor Drive contingent upon the applicants submitting a corrected Affidavit of Transfer and Statement of Compliance, which includes a complete list of unpaid accounts for alcoholic beverages, the Corporation's Articles of Incorporation, Certificate of Good Standing, Purchase Agreement, and fully complete routing sheet. 
