- 8 SPECIAL EVENTS PERMIT APPLICATION – BEER, WINE & SPIRITUOUS LIQUOR LICENSE – LA GENTE YOUTH SPORTS, INC., 2804 E. 12TH STREET, EVENT MANAGER: ZACHARY VALDEZ, (EVENT TO BE HELD JULY 15, 16, 17, 2016. ADDRESS OF EVENT: 1200 BLOCK OF JUAN MADRID AVENUE)**

Event Manager Zachary Valdez, 2804 E. 12th Street, Pueblo was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. The event is a fundraiser for La Gente with proceeds going to their youth programs. Mr. Valdez stated that there will be one liquor distribution point with two servers during the event. The menu includes La Gente burgers, hamburgers, hot dogs, chips, soda, and water. Mr. Valdez described approved forms of identification and gave examples. This is an all age's event. Wrist bands will be utilized for bar patrons. Mr. Valdez explained that the premises will be secured by orange security fencing. American Security will be on-site for the event. Because this is a multi-day event, beer is stored in a lockable beer truck overnight.

Mr. Rose, seconded by Mr. Ferris, moved to approve the special events permit application for La Gente Youth Sports, Inc. Roll Call: Ayes – Ferris, Harrison, Pullaro, and Rose. Motion carried 4-0.

- 9 SPECIAL EVENTS PERMIT APPLICATION – BEER, WINE & SPIRITUOUS LIQUOR LICENSE – BOYS & GIRLS CLUBS OF PUEBLO COUNTY, 635 WEST CORONA AVENUE, EVENT MANAGER: JACKIE SEYBOLD, (EVENT TO BE HELD JULY 15, 2016. ADDRESS OF EVENT: 115 W. B STREET - ALLEY)**

Boys & Girls Clubs President Melanie Bravo, 2018 Court Street, Pueblo and Event Manager Jackie Seybold, 1023 Pinecrest Drive, Pueblo were sworn in and answered questions from the Board. The event is a wine tasting fundraiser being held in the Neon Alley with proceeds going to the Boys & Girls Clubs of Pueblo County in support of their after school programs. Ms. Seybold stated that there will be 10 vendors with 2 vendors per table. The menu includes steak and chicken being catered by B Street Cafe. Ms. Bravo and Ms. Seybold described approved forms of identification and gave examples. This is an age 21 and older event; therefore, all attendees will have their identification checked by two volunteer staff members who are TIPS trained. Wrist bands will also be utilized. Ms. Seybold explained that the premises will be secured by barricades supplied by Work Zone. Capacity for the event is 110 people. Currently there are 50 tickets sold at \$35 per ticket.

Mr. Ferris, seconded by Mr. Rose, moved to approve the special events permit application for the Boys & Girls Clubs of Pueblo County contingent upon receiving an amended diagram and approval of the revocable permit by City Council on July 11, 2016. Roll Call: Ayes – Ferris, Harrison, Pullaro, and Rose. Motion carried 4-0.

- 10 COMMUNICATION FROM VALERIE PALUMBO, TAX AUDIT MANAGER, RE: ALLEGED SALES AND USE TAX CODE VIOLATION – SIL GLO INC. D/B/A ALOHA GLORYA'S, 313 N. MAIN STREET. (DATE OF COMMUNICATION: JUNE 16, 2016)**

Assistant City Attorney Linda Stanley appeared on behalf of the Sales Tax Division. Corporate Officer Rudy Gutierrez, 501 Grace Avenue, Pueblo appeared and was sworn in.

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Mr. Gutierrez testified that the sales and use tax code violation was an oversight on his part and that the taxes have now been paid. Mr. Gutierrez provided a copy of his most recent paid tax return and his liquor license renewal application, which was signed off by Sales Tax.

Mr. Pullaro moved to receive and file the communication. No second was received. Mr. Ferris moved to receive and file the communication contingent upon proof of payment from Tax Audit Manager Valerie Palumbo. Mr. Ferris withdrew his motion.

Mr. Ferris, seconded by Mr. Pullaro, moved to continue the communication to the July 20, 2016 regular meeting. Roll Call: Ayes — Ferris, Harrison, Pullaro, and Rose. Motion carried 4-0.


