Event Manager Larry Atencio, 3 Briargate Place, Pueblo and Leslie Nazario, 400 W. This is an all age’s event; therefore, wrist bands will be utilized for bar patrons. Beer will be purchased with tickets and one beer per person will be allowed to be purchased at a time. There will be two entrance/exit points with at least one security person per entrance. The premises will be secured by snow fencing. Security will be provided by volunteers from the Sister Cities Commission, American Hawk Security Services, park rangers, and the Pueblo Police Department will be patrolling the area.


**11 PERMIT APPLICATION & REPORT OF CHANGES – MODIFICATION OF PREMISES —TAVERN
