
- 1 SPECIAL EVENTS PERMIT APPLICATION – BEER, WINE & SPIRITUOUS LIQUOR LICENSE – FRIENDS OF FOOTBALL, INC., MAILING ADDRESS: 504 GRAND AVENUE, EVENT MANAGER: JAMES BEATTY, (EVENTS TO BE HELD SEPTEMBER 10, 2016, SEPTEMBER 17, 2016, SEPTEMBER 24, 2016, OCTOBER 15, 2016, NOVEMBER 5, 2016, AND NOVEMBER 12, 2016. ADDRESS OF EVENT: NETA & EDDIE DEROSE THUNDERBOWL, 2301 RAWLINGS BOULEVARD)**

Dan De Rose, 29677 Hegler Court, Pueblo representing Friends of Football, Inc. and Event Manager James Beatty, 5815 Good Pasture Drive, Beulah were sworn in and answered questions from the Board. No one appeared in opposition. The events are the six home football games for the CSU-Pueblo Thunderwolves. The events are fundraisers for the Friends of Football and not CSU-Pueblo. Friends of Football receives a 30 percent commission from the sale of food and beverages. There are four distribution sites on the west side of the stadium and four distribution sites on the east side of the stadium with roaming vendors selling beer only. There are approximately 75 employees, most are TIPS certified. Hamburgers, hot dogs, popcorn, peanuts, etc. are available for purchase. Approved forms of identification were explained and examples given. Wrist bands will not be utilized for the first game, but may be utilized at future games if needed. All identification will be checked for anyone wanting to purchase liquor. The premises is secured by fencing in its entirety and the Pueblo County Sheriff's Department will be on site to provide security.

Mr. Ferris, seconded by Mr. Pullaro, moved to approve the special events permit application for the Friends of Football, Inc. Roll Call: Ayes – Ferris, Harrison, and Pullaro. Motion carried 3-0.

ADJOURN – With no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 2:01 p.m.
