D/B/A GRAHAMS GRILL, 1749 S. PUEBLO BOULEVARD**

For the record, it was determined there was no one present in opposition to this application.

Member Heather Graham, 50 Posada Drive, Pueblo and Registered Manager Vivian Hutto, 93 Radcliff Lane, Pueblo were sworn in and answered questions from the Board.

The moral character and financial interest questions were directed to the applicant. The applicant is currently hiring wait staff; however, there will be approximately 15 employees. Background investigations are currently not conducted on employees; however, the applicant tends to hire people that she knows personally. Some staff will be working at both locations of Grahams Grill. Approved forms of identification were described and examples given by both Ms. Graham and Ms. Hutto. Anyone wishing to purchase liquor will have their identification checked. All the staff will attend a safe serve class, probably before opening the new location. The moral character of the applicant was found to be satisfactory to the Board.

Chairwoman Harrison gave specific information as to how the Board arrived at the number of valid signatures on the petitions. The petitions were admitted into evidence as Exhibit A.

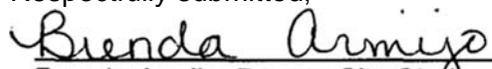
