4 NEIGHBORHOOD SURVEY: NEW HOTEL & RESTAURANT LIQUOR LICENSE – BBDD MANAGEMENT, INC. D/B/A BEATTY’S ARENA & CLASSIC CATERING CO., 2301 RAWLINGS BOULEVARD

James Beatty, 5815 Good Pasture Drive, Beulah and Dan DeRose, 29677 Hegler Court, Pueblo were sworn in. Mr. Beatty and Mr. DeRose have concerns regarding the expanded radius of one mile for this neighborhood survey. The neighborhood survey was reviewed and discussed. It was noted that in previous cases the radius has been expanded accordingly depending on the circumstances of the applicant.

Mr. Pullaro, seconded by Ms. Shafer, moved to accept the survey and set this matter for hearing on February 1, 2017.

After extensive discussion, the Board agreed that they would like to have an additional survey prepared with a ¾ mile boundary in addition to the 1 mile boundary survey.

Mr. Pullaro, seconded by Mr. Rose, moved to continue this matter to the February 1, 2017 meeting and have a ¾ mile neighborhood survey prepared for consideration. Roll Call: Ayes – Ferris, Harrison, Pullaro, Rose, and Shafer. Motion carried 5-0.

5 REPORT OF CHANGES – CORPORATION, LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY AND PARTNERSHIP – TAVERN LIQUOR LICENSE – SANGRE DE CRISTO ARTS AND CONFERENCE CENTER, INC. D/B/A SANGRE DE CRISTO ARTS AND CONFERENCE CENTER, 210 N. SANTA FE AVENUE (NEW CHAIRPERSON PATRICIA GONZALEZ REPLACES TIM O’SHEA, NEW VICE-CHAIRPERSON DOROTHY O’DOWD REPLACES PAT GONZALEZ, NEW SECRETARY ELISSA BALL REPLACES DOROTHY O’DOWD)

New Chairperson Patricia Gonzalez, 1886 E. County Farm Road, Pueblo and Registered Manager Lorrie Marquez, 3226 St. Clair Avenue, Pueblo were sworn in and answered questions from the Board. The moral character questions were directed to Ms. Gonzalez and Ms. Marquez. Currently the Arts Center employs six to eight people with no known criminal convictions during events requiring liquor service. Background checks are completed on employees. Approved forms of identification were described and examples given by both Ms. Gonzalez and Ms. Marquez. Anyone appearing under age 30 will have their identification checked. The Board encouraged Seller-Server training for staff. The Arts Center is considering training, but due to budgetary constraints it probably won’t occur during the first six months of the year.

Mr. Rose, seconded by Ms. Shafer, moved to approve the Report of Changes – Tavern Liquor License – Sangre de Cristo Arts and Conference Center, Inc. d/b/a Sangre de Cristo Arts and Conference Center. Roll Call: Ayes — Ferris, Harrison, Pullaro, Rose, and Shafer. Motion carried 5-0.

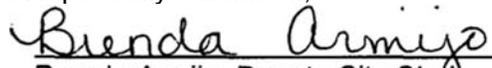
