Event Manager Mack Novosad, 622 Tyler Street, Pueblo was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. The event will be catered by Rudy's BBQ. The menu will include pork, chicken, and beef barbeque, beans, salad, bread, pie, tea, and water. There will be one liquor distribution point with eight to ten servers. Approved forms of identification were explained and examples given. Anyone appearing under the age of 50 will have their identification checked. Identification will be checked at the entrance and bar. All servers are TIP certified. The perimeter of the building is fenced and the fenced parking lot is monitored by airport security. The premises are also monitored by cameras.

Mr. Ferris, seconded by Mr. Pullaro, moved to approve the special events permit application for the Pueblo Historical Aircraft Society. Roll Call: Ayes – Ferris, Harrison, Pullaro, Rose, and Shafer. Motion carried 5-0.

**7 HEARING: NEW HOTEL & RESTAURANT LIQUOR LICENSE – BBDD MANAGEMENT, INC. D/B/A BEATTY'S ARENA & CLASSIC CATERING CO., 2301 RAWLINGS BOULEVARD**

For the record, it was determined there was no one present in opposition to this application.

Raquel Lee Vigil, 3508 Ringtail Lane, Pueblo and Jeffery Vigil, 3508 Ringtail Lane, Pueblo were sworn in and answered questions from the Board.

The moral character and financial interest questions were directed to the applicants individually. Neither applicant has served in the military. There are no silent partners. The applicants sold their food truck and utilized savings to finance operation of the business. Approved forms of identification were described and examples given. The restaurant currently employees ten people with a possibility of employing up to 20 individuals. Due to the employees being mostly family, background investigations are currently not conducted on employees. The moral character of the applicant was found to be satisfactory to the Board.

Chairwoman Harrison gave specific information as to how the Board arrived at the number of valid signatures on the petitions. The petitions were admitted into evidence as Exhibit A.


