Event Manager Silvester Abron, 1725 Bonny Brae Lane, Pueblo and Lawrence DePriest, 4903 Briarcrest Drive, Pueblo, were sworn in and answered questions from the Board. There will be one liquor distribution point and two sellers at the Beer Garden. Wristbands will be utilized for bar patrons. Approved forms of identification were explained and examples given. Anyone wishing to purchase liquor will have their identification checked. Three Titan security offices will provide security, as well as the sheriff's department bike patrol patrolling the area. There will be one entry point and two exit points at the site. The premises will also be secured by temporary barricades.

The Board questioned Mr. Abron and Mr. DePriest concerning the diagram. The Board requested that the diagram be amended to clearly mark the entrance and exit points, remove the 20'x30' section that was mistakenly added to the licensed premises, and indicate North on the diagram.

Ms. Shafer, seconded by Mr. Rose, moved to approve the special events permit application contingent upon receipt of an amended diagram for Juneteenth Organization of Pueblo Inc. Roll Call: Ayes – Harrison, Pullaro, Rose, and Shafer. Motion carried 4-0.


