This fundraiser is a softball game between Bikers vs. Sheriff. The proceeds will be used to purchase school supplies for local students. There will be one liquor distribution point and a maximum of three servers. Servers attend in-house training. Wristbands will be utilized for bar patrons. Hamburgers, hot dogs, chips, soda, and water will be available for purchase. Approved forms of identification were explained and examples given. All people entering the secured area will have their identification checked. Eight sheriff deputies will provide security. The premises will also be secured by temporary fencing and a tent set up for liquor and food sales.
