Corporate Officer Keith Avery, 2119 Chatalet Lane, Pueblo, CO was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. No one appeared in opposition to the application. The moral character and financial interest questions were directed to Mr. Avery. Approved forms of identification were explained and examples given. The moral character of the applicant was found to be satisfactory to the Board.

Chairwoman Harrison gave specific information as to how the Board arrived at the number of valid signatures on the petitions. The Board expressed concern about signatures of businesses being included on the residential petitions and the number of signatures that were disqualified because of this error.

Mr. Pullaro, seconded by Mr. Rose, moved to continue this item to the August 2, 2017 Regular Meeting to allow the applicant time to continue petitioning the neighborhood. Roll Call: Ayes – Harrison, Pullaro, Rose, and Shafer. Motion carried 4-0.

Executive Director Steve Trujillo, 825 Edna Way, Pueblo, CO and Event Manager Dennis Lowry, 220 West 15<sup>th</sup> Street, Pueblo, CO were sworn in and answered questions from the Board. Attorney Joe Koncilja was also present. This fundraiser will benefit programs sponsored by the Latino Chamber. There will be one liquor distribution point with four servers plus Latino Chamber staff members. Volunteers will be trained prior to the event. Food truck vendors will be on site as well as area restaurants to provide food sales. Wristbands will be utilized for bar patrons. Approved forms of identification were explained and examples given. Identification will be checked at the B Street entrance and again at the beer tent. Titan Security will provide security. The premises will also be secured by barricades.



This wine and cheese tasting fundraiser will benefit programs sponsored by the Boys & Girls Clubs. There will be nine tables throughout the location with two servers per table.
