Registered Manager Lee Deeg, 1202 W. 24th Street, Pueblo, CO and Assistant General Manager Felipe Garcia, 3527 Bobcat Lane, Pueblo, CO were sworn in and answered questions from the Board. This modification of premises will extend the licensed premises of the Convention Center across Main Street for an event to be held in conjunction with the Medal of Honor Convention. There will be three liquor distribution points and a total of six bartenders. Everyone appearing under the age of 50 will have their identification checked. Security will be stationed at the access points and throughout the venue. The premises will also be secured by temporary fencing around the entire outdoor area. Bar patrons will be allowed to purchase two drinks at a time. All bartenders are Safe Serve certified.

Ms. Harrison, seconded by Mr. Pullaro, moved to approve the Report of Changes – Modification of Premises – Global Spectrum Colo LP d/b/a Pueblo Convention Center contingent upon receipt of an amended diagram showing entrances/exits and locations of liquor distribution points, and a completed routing sheet. 

There is one entrance/exit for the facility. Buffalo Wind Wings is donating the food for the event. Approved forms of identification were explained and examples given. Wristbands will be utilized for bar patrons. The caddies will act as wait staff and purchase drinks for those golfing. Boys & Girls Clubs staff and Epic Entertainment employees will provide security for the event. The premises will also be secured by permanent fencing.
