Event Manager Kimber Weddle, 935 Village Circle, #B, Pueblo, CO and Executive Director Abigail Krause, 6185 Pennsylvania Avenue, Beulah, CO were sworn in and answered questions from the Board. This fundraiser is to be held in conjunction with the Christmas tree lighting at the Pueblo Zoo. The proceeds will benefit the Zoo. There will be one liquor distribution point and a maximum of two servers. Kimber will act as one of the servers at the event and is TIPS certified. Wristbands will be utilized for bar patrons. The Candy Cane Café will have popcorn, chips, candy, and cookies available for purchase. The Safari Café will have sandwiches, cheese, salami, and crackers, and peanuts available for purchase. Hot chocolate and coffee will also be available. Approved forms of identification were explained and examples given. There will be two security guards at the event – one at the gate entrance. Staff will provide additional security and the park rangers will be on call. The premises are secured by permanent fencing.


