D/B/A AA SUPER BUFFET, 3020 HART ROAD**

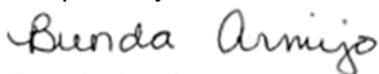
Corporate Officer Kim Ching Chow, 9 Chicory Court, Pueblo, CO was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. No one appeared in opposition to the application. The moral character and financial interest questions were directed to the applicant. Approved forms of identification were explained and examples given. The restaurant currently employs 13 – 14 full-time employees. Background checks are not currently done; however, the applicant indicated he may utilize background checks in the future. Patrons will have their identification checked upon entry to the restaurant and again at the table when receiving their drink order. The applicant is making arrangements to complete TIPS training.

Chairperson Rose gave specific information as to how the Board arrived at the number of valid signatures on the petitions. The Board expressed concern about business signatures being on the residential petitions. The Board disqualified the business petitions and directed the applicant to repetition the businesses located within the defined area. The residential petitions were admitted into evidence as Exhibit A.

Ms. Harrison, seconded by Mr. Pullaro, moved to continue this item to the February 2, 2018 Regular Meeting to allow the applicant time to repetition the businesses and supplement the residential petitions. Roll Call: Ayes – Harrison, Pullaro, Rose, Shafer, Sowinski. Motion carried 5-0.
