Currently the club employs five people with no known criminal convictions. Approved forms of identification were described and examples given by Mr. Robles. All club members must be at least 21 years of age. Club policy is to check identification for anyone who appears 21 or younger. Employees and Board members are required to attend TIPS training.

Mr. Pullaro, seconded by Ms. Shafer, moved to approve the Report of Changes – Club Liquor License – Fraternal Order of Eagles #3367 d/b/a Steel City Eagles Aerie #3367 contingent upon receipt of a complete criminal history for Secretary Lisa Mielnicki. Member Michael Mahan, 2 La Hambra Court, Pueblo, CO was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. The moral character and financial questions were directed to Mr. Mahan. Currently the Gold Dust employs 12 people. All employees are staff from the previous owner. Background investigations will be conducted in the future on prospective employees and there are no known convictions for current employees. Approved forms of identification were described and examples given. The Gold Dust policy is to check the identification of anyone appearing under 40 years of age. The moral character of Mr. Mahan was found to be satisfactory to the Board.


