Event Manager Kyle Groves, 138 Glenn Place, Pueblo, CO was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. There will be one liquor distribution point with one server. The events will be catered by Olive Garden. Approved forms of identification were described and examples given. Anyone wishing to purchase liquor will be have their identification checked and wristbands will be utilized for bar patrons. There is one entry/exit point for this event. There is a back door to the facility which patrons will not have access to and will remain locked.

Ms. Montgomery, seconded by Mr. Tony Pullaro, moved to approve the special events permit application for Theater of Mystery Corp. Roll Call: Ayes — Montgomery, Pullaro, Pullaro, and Shafer. Motion carried 4-0.

Sr. Vice Commander Derrick Padilla, 23 Carousel Lane, Pueblo, CO was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. The moral character questions were directed to Mr. Padilla. Currently the American Legion has ten employees, which includes servers, office staff, and maintenance workers. Approved forms of identification were described and examples given by Mr. Padilla. Identification is checked for any new, unfamiliar patrons. Mr. Padilla explained that their patrons are all members of the American Legion. Servers have received liquor training. Moral character was found to be satisfactory to the Board.

Mr. Charles Pullaro, seconded by Mr. Tony Pullaro, moved to continue the Report of Changes – Club Liquor License – American Legion Post 2 to the January 2, 2019 hearing to allow the New Commander Steve Nurre to appear before the Board. The Board expressed concern that beer would be located in an end cap and the possibility of shoplifting. Mr. Stavang stated that cashiers will be trained to watch for shoplifters in that location.



Mr. Wilson stated that checkers have been trained on approved identification and that all beer patrons will have their identification checked.
