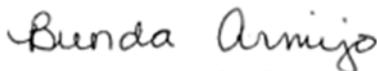

Commander Steve Nurre, 4073 40th Lane, Avondale, CO was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. The moral character questions were directed to Mr. Nurre. Currently the American Legion has six employees, with no known convictions. Background checks of prospective employees are not done. Approved forms of identification were described and examples given by Mr. Nurre. Only members can order drinks. A member must be over 18, but at least 21 to drink. Mr. Nurre did not know if servers have received training. The moral character of the applicant was found to be satisfactory to the Board.
