In the process of gutting the interior of the new Human Services building workers have come across asbestos. Abatement will slow things down

### **Transportation: Pepper Whittlef**

Transit is working on a Google Maps app that will allow passengers to check on the exact location of their bus in real time. The trial revealed some glitches that have to be fixed.
