Attorney Brian Proffitt, #31101, Runco & Proffitt, P.C., 1616 17th Street, Suite 376, Denver, CO again appeared on behalf of the applicant. Wendy Maldonado, General Manager, Cinemark Tinseltown 14 Pueblo, 4307 Wilderness Trail, Pueblo, CO remained sworn in. In response to additional questioning by the Board, Ms. Maldonado stated that there will be one security guard on-site at this time. There are no plans to mark or utilize wristbands for bar patrons. No liquor will be sold to non-patrons. Patrons must have a ticket to a movie to be sold liquor. For clarification, the liquor policy for Cinemark is a two drink maximum per person per visit to the concession stand.

The Cinemark Liquor Policy was entered into the record as Exhibit C.

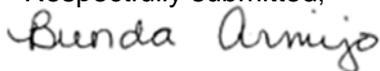
