**1 HEARING: NEW HOTEL AND RESTAURANT LIQUOR LICENSE – HAWKS ENTERPRISES, LLC D/B/A CHELSEY’S WINGS BURGERS AND SPIRITS, 727 NORTH MAIN STREET**

For the record, it was determined there was no one present in opposition to the issuance of this license.

Managing Member James Hawks, Pueblo West Campground, 480 E. McCulloch Boulevard, Pueblo West, CO was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. Pete Soto, 2209 Moline Avenue, Pueblo, CO was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. Brian Casaus, 1923 Euclid Avenue, Pueblo, CO was sworn and testified in favor of the application. The Moral Character and Financial questions were directed to Mr. Hawks. There are currently ten employees with no known convictions. Background checks will not be conducted on prospective employees. Approved forms of identification were described and examples given. Anyone appearing under 50 years of age will have their identification checked. The applicant will be attending the training hosted by the City of Pueblo in April. The moral character of the applicant is acceptable to the Board.

Petitions were admitted into evidence as Exhibit A.

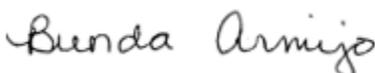
