**5 HEARING: NEW TAVERN LIQUOR LICENSE – HAWKS ENTRPRISES, LLC, D/B/A
CERVEZAS CANTINA, 310 WEST NORTHERN AVENUE**

Owner, James Hawks appeared before the board. Assistant City Attorney, Kyle Aber advised the board was concerned about the wants and needs of the neighborhood as only 87 residents signed in favor out of 2700 residents and only 14 businesses out of 186, and the board could either vote on the basis of the current petitions, or the petitioner could attempt to get more signatures. Mr. Hawks would like to attempt to get more signatures and will be at the next Liquor Board meeting on March 17th.

Mr. Cornetta, seconded by Mr. Rose, motioned to continue the New Tavern Liquor License – Hawks Enterprises, LLC, d/b/a Cervezas Cantina, 310 West Northern Avenue to the March 17th, 2021 Liquor Board Meeting. Roll Call: Ayes – Chapman, Cornetta, Pullaro, Rose, and Shafer. Motion carried 5-0.
