**V. Old/New Businesses**

1. **Rayne resignation** Bart Mitikotivich (Pueblo Planner) mother has applied to HPC. Howell asked if that's a conflict and Broadhead said he'd look into that.

2. **National Trust Recognition of Colorado's Chicano Murals: Pueblo Site**

Broadhead reported the National Trust designated Colorado's Chicano murals an endangered place and the Leo Lucero mural in Plaza Verde Park was designated. Broadhead said they can't landmark murals because there are no building permits. He stated that the code allows for designation of sites so we'd like to move forward on designation of murals in Colorado. Broadhead mentioned Plaza Verde would be an

eligible designation and maybe landmarking the mural might be a good representation of the park and struggle. Staff doesn't have to wait to work on this effort. Howell suggested Pueblo be the thought leader on landmarking of murals. Broadhead suggested a management plan could be adopted as part of the ordinance. Broadhead said you look to see what the community thinks is significant, and you run with what they point out. Howell mentioned landmarking of graffiti in Sao Paolo for best practices.

### **3. Landmark Updates 2022**

Broadhead mentioned one of the main points of the HPC is to get landmarks and one the Steelworkers Union building near the mill. Howell mentioned that they were moving forward with the Alfred Crowell house on the east side. There are no landmarks on the East Side other than St. Leander's. The Aberdeen Apartments owner talked to Broadhead about landmarking the building.

4. **First AME Church-** There is a kickoff meeting for a small designation grant from State Historical Fund May 24<sup>th</sup>. Tom and Laurie Simmons will be conducting the writing of the designation. The landmark will be local first then national.
