New manager, Lynn McKenzie, 2022 Pepperwood Drive, Colorado Springs, CO was sworn in and answered questions from the Board. The moral character of Ms. McKenzie was satisfactory to the Board. Ms. McKenzie has worked at Applebee’s for 15 years and the licensee has never received a violation or reprimand for violating liquor licensing statutes or regulations. Ms. McKenzie stated they employ approximately 50-75 employees and stated she did not know whether or not these employees had ever pled guilty to or been convicted of a crime other than a minor traffic offense. Ms. McKenzie stated they do not conduct background investigations on potential employees; however, they do check

employment references and potential employees go through two interviews with their managers. Ms. McKenzie described approved forms of ID and stated they request identification from anyone who appears under the age of 30. All managers are serve-safe certified and their new employees receive 5 days in-house training when they are first employed.

Mr. Ferris, seconded by Mr. DiFatta, moved to approve this manager registration. Roll Call: Ayes—DiFatta, Ferris, Harrison, Pullaro and Rose. Motion carried unanimously.

Manager Catherine Richardson, 4932 Warbler Court, was sworn in and explained the proposed modification to the Board. Ms. Richardson stated the remodel work is primarily cosmetic and will result in a reconfiguration of the seating to allow for better flow and seating will increase from 255 to 285 seats. She explained they will be removing tables and installing more booths. Ms. Richardson stated the remodel job is scheduled to begin around July 13th, 2012 and will take approximately 10-weeks to complete. The restaurant will remain open while the remodel work is being performed.

Mr. Pullaro, seconded by Mr. Ferris, moved to approve this modification pending receipt of the Routing Sheet. Roll Call: Ayes—DiFatta, Ferris, Harrison, Pullaro and Rose. Motion carried unanimously.
