Mr. Hayes opened the meeting at 10:02 am.

The Board reviewed the minutes from the May 15, 2025, Pueblo Transit Board meeting. Mayor Graham moved to approve the minutes. Mr. Hayes seconded. Motion passed.


The staff from Mead & Hunt reviewed the results of the Pueblo Transit Areas of Persistent Poverty Technical Report they performed for Pueblo Transit. Their findings resulted in three transit expansion recommendations. These recommendations will be taken under advisement by the board. The amount of funding available to Pueblo Transit will determine the ability to implement any route changes or additions.

Mr. Lopez briefly reviewed the SB 230 CTE Grant award. Due to the award of the grant relief application, there is no match owed by Pueblo Transit for the grant. Training is planned for 2026, and implementation is planned for 2027.

Mr. Valdez reviewed the 10-Year Plan \$3.1 million-dollar apportionment. The Transit liaison from our region informed us that they (CDOT) are in the final part of forgiving the match requirement for our 10 Year Plan capital Funds for Bus replacement in the amount of 3.1 million dollars. We should have confirmation in the next few weeks.

Mr. Valdez provided the board with the agreement between Pueblo Community College and Pueblo Transit to provide free bus service to current, active PCC students. Program will be implemented within the next 30 days.
